buildings some  
built as early as the  
17th Century.



All of the Reclaimed French Oak is processed by hand ensuring that every plank is checked for quality.

We de nail visually, power wash, clip ends, kiln dry, pack strap and load for export.



The Reclaimed French Oak is salvaged as planks from very old farm houses the walls are generally 8 inch wide and 2 to 5 inch thick. Lengths range from 6 to 14 foot



This lumber has travelled an amazing journey surviving unscarred through a plethora of European combat and two world wars.

The lumber is 'old growth' and history tells us it was uniquely selected and cut down by hand, rough sawn which is completely unmatched by new lumber today.
